### Information to consider when your child starts school in 2018

Dear Parents/Guardians

The requirement for parents/legal guardians to complete and submit a new application form each year has been removed.

Parents/legal guardians are only required to submit a CSEF application form to the school in the following circumstances:

- Parents/legal guardians applying for CSEF for the first time - i.e. an application form was not lodged with the school the previous year (e.g. prep enrolment), OR
- Changed family circumstances e.g. change of custody, change of name or CRN, or a new sibling(s) commencing at the school.
